

# FLOWER COLOUR MESS FACTOR 0/10 MATCHING

Such a fun educational activity for your Little Bug – combining colour matching with fine motor skills. So simple to make, with items you can find around your home!

# Step 1:

Cut a rectangle from a cardboard box – a sturdier cardboard is best!

#### Step 2:

Using paint, or markers, colour the pasta in corresponding colours to your pipe cleaners.

### Step 3:

Once the painted pasta is dried, glue to the cardboard

#### Step 4:

Bend your pipe cleaners into flower shapes, try to ensure a reasonable "stem" to be threaded through the pasta



## Step 5:

Add any decoration you may like!

## Step 6:

Ask your Little Bug to match the flowers with the colours, and thread through! Allow them to explore, removing and re-threading the pipe cleaners
